Vision Council Award

Awarded to a company, facility, or department for working throughout the calendar year without an eye injury in the workplace.

Board of Directors Award

Awarded to a company, facility, or department for working two consecutive calendar years year without an eye injury in the workplace. The recipients must have previously won the Vision Council Award.

President's Award

Awarded to a company, facility, or department for working three consecutive calendar years year without an eye injury in the workplace. The recipients must have previously won the Board of Directors Award.

President's Continued Excellence Award

Awarded to a company, facility, or department for working four or more consecutive calendar years without an eye injury in the workplace.
